

COOKIES POLICY

AVAFIN HOLDING, LTD, with TAX No. CY 103353450, Reg. Number: HE335345; and with registered address at 40 Kimonos Street, 3095, Limassol, Cyprus (“**Avafin**” or “**us**”), uses first-party and third-party cookies and/or similar technologies which collect and store information as you browse. In general, these technologies may be used for very different purposes, such as, for example, to enable the functions and services of the website, to smooth user browsing experience, to track website visitors and analytics, to recognize you as a user, to obtain information about your browsing habits, or personalize the way the contents are displayed to you.

In accordance with the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (“**GDPR**”), and with other applicable legislations, this Cookies Policy is intended to inform the website users about the cookies used at <https://avafin.com> (“**Avafin website**”) in a clear and comprehensive manner.

Avafin is considered a Controller within the meaning of the GDPR, and the user has all the rights set out in the Privacy Policy available at the link <https://avafin.com>.

A user is any data subject who uses the Avafin website and, communications, and services (hereinafter referred to as the "User").

Please bear in mind that you will have to give your consent in order us to use certain cookies when you access the Avafin website. However, please note that the following cookies are exempted from the requirement of informed consent: cookies used for the sole purpose of carrying out the transmission of a communication over an electronic communications network; cookies strictly necessary in order to provide a service explicitly requested by the user; “user access” cookies; load balancing session cookies; cookies for user interface personalization; user security cookies; or user identification or authentication cookies (session cookies only).

1. What are cookies?

Computer cookies are small files used by web servers to save browsing information, allowing websites to remember your device, browser preferences, and associated online activity. This data is labeled with a randomly generated ID to identify unique visitors. Cookies can gather information about the use of a website or enable the website to recognize the user as an existing customer when they return to the website at a later date. The information collected by cookies is generic, and under no circumstances allows us to obtain or infer data such as your name, surname, ID number, email address, postal address or other similar private information.

Keep into account that if the cookies are disabled, certain functionalities of the website may not work properly, so your user experience might not be fully satisfactory. Additionally, at any time, you can withdraw your consent to our use of cookies on our website and change your browser settings in order to prevent the installation of these files, as we will explain later.

2. What are the different types of cookies?

Cookies can be classified according to several criteria:

- **Cookie categories as per managing entity:** First-party and third-party cookies

First-party cookies are installed directly by the website (the URL shown in the browser's address bar). These cookies enable us to collect analytics data, remember language settings, and perform other useful functions that provide good user experience.

Third-party cookies are installed by third parties with the aim of collecting certain information from web users to carry out research into, for example, behavior, demographics or spending habits. They are commonly used by advertisers who want to ensure that products and services are marketed towards the right target audience.

When cookies are served from a device or domain managed by our web editor, but the information collected by such cookies is subsequently managed and processed exclusively by a third party, they may not be considered as our first-party cookies if the said third party uses them for their own purposes (for example, for improving the services provided by such third party or to provide advertising services in favor of other entities).

- **Cookie categories as per their purpose.** Strictly necessary, Performance, Targeting, Functionality cookies

Strictly necessary cookies allow core website functionalities, such as user login and account management. The website cannot be used properly without strictly necessary cookies.

Performance cookies are used to see how visitors use the website, e.g. analytics cookies. Those cookies cannot be used to directly identify a certain visitor.

Targeting cookies are used to identify visitors between different websites, e.g. content partners, banner networks. Those cookies may be used by companies to build a profile of visitor interests or show relevant ads on other websites.

Functionality cookies are used to remember visitor information on the website, e.g. language, time zone, enhanced content.

- **Types of cookies based on activity period** Session and persistent cookies

Session cookies are cookies designed to collect and store data while users access a website. They are regularly used to store information that is only relevant with regard to the provision of the services requested by users in a single situation (for example, a list of purchased products) and disappear once the session is closed.

Persistent cookies stay stored and may be accessed and processed for a period of time defined by the cookie manager, which may range from a few minutes to several years.

3. Consent to cookies

If the above-mentioned files contain personal data, the legal basis for processing such data is the user's consent – Article 6(1)(a) of the GDPR.

When accessing the Avafin website, the User may, via the cookie panel, refuse the use of performance, targeting, and functionality cookies. In such a case, we will not be able to maintain detailed statistics or tailor our advertisements based on information collected within the Avafin. General advertisements will, however, still be displayed on the Avafin website. Our cookie panel allows the User to edit their preferences in this respect at any time while using the Avafin website.

The User may withdraw or adjust their consent for the relevant processing purposes at any time. To facilitate this, we have created an easy-to-use tool in the form of a floating cookie icon located in the lower-left corner of the screen. Clicking the cookie icon will open the consent panel familiar to the User, where—by selecting or deselecting the appropriate checkboxes—they can easily adjust their consent to match their preferences. Withdrawal of consent will be effective only for the future, meaning that it will not affect the lawfulness of any processing carried out by Avafin prior to the withdrawal.

4. What do we use cookies for?

We use the data contained in the above-mentioned cookies for the following purposes:

- To operate and manage our website, enabling its features and functions.
- To facilitate your browsing experience.
- To prevent fraud and enhance security during your interaction with the website.
- To manage data traffic and communication on the platform.
- To identify and maintain the user session.
- To remember your preferences, providing a personalized experience and distinguishing it from other users.
- To collect relevant data, generate statistics, and analyse your browsing behaviour (including IP address, device type, operating system, referring URLs, country, date and time of visits, and pages viewed) to improve the services and products offered to you, as well as your overall browsing experience.
- To deliver customized advertisements tailored to your interests and preferences, based on profiling from your browsing activity.
- To measure user engagement and the effectiveness of our advertising campaigns. Furthermore, we inform you that our partners may also use the data obtained from your navigation to improve their own services, and to offer services to other companies (e.g. interest-based advertising).

5. Cookie handling

If you wish to delete cookies later, you must do so from your own browser, or through the means indicated by a third party. You can also obtain more information on transfers to third countries, if any, made by the owners of third-party cookies identified here, through their corresponding cookies and privacy policies that are accessible on their websites.
